SENATE RESOLUTION

AMENDING RULE 16 OF THE RULES OF THE SENATE OF THE TWENTY-NINTH
LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII.

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, First Special Session of
3 2017, that the Rules of the Senate of the State of Hawaii, the
4 Twenty-ninth Legislature, be amended by deleting paragraphs (10)
5 and (11) of Senate Rule 16 Standing Committees to read as
6 follows:

8 "~~(10) Committee on International Affairs and the Arts~~
9 ~~(IAA). The purview of this committee includes those programs~~
10 ~~relating to international affairs, international relations,~~
11 ~~foreign policy issues, and foreign relations; and culture and~~

15 ~~(11) Committee on Judiciary and Labor (JDL). The purview~~

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rules of the Senate of the
28 State of Hawaii, the Twenty-ninth Legislature, be amended by
29 adding two new paragraphs to Senate Rule 16 Standing Committees
30 to read as follows:

32 "(10) Committee on Judiciary (JDC). The purview of this
33 committee includes those programs relating to the courts, crime
34 prevention and control, including juvenile justice matters,

1 criminal code revision, statutory revision, campaign spending
2 and elections, ethics, constitutional matters, the Attorney
3 General, Public Defender, and Judiciary, and individual rights
4 and civil liberties; international affairs, international
5 relations, foreign policy issues, and foreign relations; and
6 culture and the arts in the State, including but not limited to
7 programs relating to historic preservation.

9 (11) Committee on Labor (LBR). The purview of this
10 committee includes those programs relating to public officers
11 and employees, labor, employment opportunities and training,
12 labor-management relations, collective bargaining, the
13 Employees' Retirement System, and the Hawai'i Employer-Union
14 Health Benefits Trust Fund."; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Rule material to be
17 repealed is bracketed and stricken and new Senate Rule material
18 is underscored; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendments made to the
21 Senate Rules by this Resolution take effect upon the adoption of
22 this Resolution.
