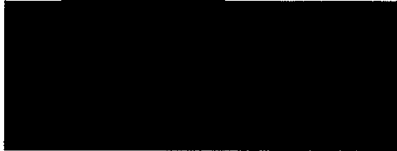

Partner in a theatrical management company, David Strong Warner, Inc. that provided general management services to shows produced by Dodger Productions and other producers, including Walt Disney Productions. In 1997, Dodger Productions merged with a Dutch entertainment conglomerate to become Dodger Endemol Productions.
